Proof of attendance at a college, university or recognized trade schools, must be furnished before the scholarship monies are transferred. Any applicant who receives the scholarship will have to furnish an address for the college or trade school and whom to make the check out to. The scholarship must be activated within two years of notification or all rights to funds will be forfeited.

All awards will be announced on or before September 1.

GSA SCHOLARSHIP SCORING PROCEDURES

The selection panel will consist of (5) people, appointed by the GSA President

Each panel member will evaluate each application. All applications will be coded to the original cover sheet of the application.

When scoring the application each member of the selection panel will evaluate each application in the different categories. When the scoring is complete the average score for each applicant will be determined by dividing the total number by five (5). A maximum of 500 points is available.

In the case of a tie, the applications involved will be re-evaluated until the tie is broken.

Notes to selection panel

- 1 Take into account high average, high game and series, awards received, league and tournament participation.
- 2 Rate applicant according to his/her contribution not only to GSA Youth Bowling, but also to his/her bowling establishment and bowling in general.
- 3 Take into consideration the applicant's courses of study or what courses have been taken. Carefully examine the difficulty of courses when looking specifically at GPA and transcripts.
- 4 School Participation is self-explanatory.
- 5 Outside interests is self-explanatory.
- 6 Evaluate on the basis of the applicant's character, temperament, dedication and future potential as determined by a maximum of two letters of reference.
