Paid entries must be in the GSA USBC office by noon on Saturday April 22, 2018. The first 40 entries received in the office are guaranteed a spot in the tournament. The tournament will be held concurrently with the GSA USBC Queens tournament. Thus the combined total entries will be limited by lane availability. If you are considering entering this tournament, then be advised to get your entry in as soon as possible.

Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** All participants must be an active 2017-18 USBC member in good standing prior to the tournament date and have reached age 50 by April 28, 2019.

2. **Dress Code:** Bowlers must be dressed in a clean and presentable manner. Slacks or capris are acceptable. Collared shirts or bowling shirts similar to that permitted on the PWBA or PBA including mock tees or v-necks are required. Prohibited items include denim jeans, cut offs, tank tops, shorts, spandex, sweats, t-shirts, **hats**, and shirts or equipment with offensive wording or pictures.

3. **Format:** Bowlers will bowl 5 games across five pairs of lanes on a sport compliant oil pattern. After 5 games, the field will be cut in half. The highest remaining totals will bowl 2 additional games of qualifying. The top 5 seven game totals from qualifying will proceed to a stepladder final. A tie for the final spot of stepladder play will be decided by a one frame roll-off. Ties between all other bowlers qualifying for stepladder play will be decided by a one frame roll off for seeding purposes. Matches of the top 5 qualifiers will be decided by a one game single elimination until only two competitors remain. The final two competitors will bowl a two-game total pin fall match for the championship. Any tie after the two game matches will be decided by a single frame roll off and continue until one competitor outscores the other.

4. **Awards:** Bowlers advancing to match play will cash. If no super senior (age 60+) qualifies for stepladder play, the highest scoring super senior will receive a cash award. Additional awards are dependent on the number of entries.

5. **Other Rules:**

- **Conduct:** Good sportsmanship is required by all participants. Any unsporting behavior will be addressed by the tournament committee and may result in a warning or disqualification.

- **General Provisions:** Only participants and tournament personnel are allowed in the settee area. No food or drink is allowed in the settee area. No powdery product (e.g. Easy Slide, baby powder) may be applied to bowling shoes at any time. No audio devices are permitted in the settee area. Cell phones must be in the silent setting.

- **Protests/Appeals:** Any protest or appeal must be presented to the Tournament Chair prior the start of a new game. USBC rules will govern any aspect of tournament played that is not specifically addressed in these rules.
