**Dress Code:** All bowlers must wear suitable attire which must be neat, clean and in good condition. **No** inappropriate advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. Jeans, slacks, walking shorts, capri pants and skirts are permitted. **No** t-shirts, tank tops, halter tops, hats, sweats, gym shorts, or cut-offs of any kind allowed. Skirts and shorts must be hemmed and not be more than 3" above the knee. The tournament staff shall determine and enforce as necessary.

## Tournament Rules

- 1. Eligibility:** All participants must be active GSA 2018-19 USBC members in good standing prior to the tournament date.
- 2. Format:** Scratch and handicap divisions available where entrants will bowl 3 games of doubles on same pair of lanes only. Entrants may bowl multiple squads as long as a different team member is used. Multiple entries are encouraged.
- 3. Average:** Entrants must use their highest 2017-2018 fall/winter season average of at least 21 games or, if your January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 average is more than 10 pins higher than your 2017-2018 average, the 10 pin drop rule will be in effect (i.e. 17-18 avg is 160, Jan 1<sup>st</sup> avg is 190, your tournament average would be 180) if none, provide a league standing sheet from the current season of at least 21 games. If neither is available, entrant will be assigned an average of 230. Entrants are responsible for verifying their own average at the time entry form is submitted. If the tournament committee finds an incorrectly reported average, a corrected average may be used or the entrant may be disqualified.
- 4. Handicap:** Handicaps will be calculated at 90% of the difference between the team average and 430.
- 5. Awards:** A ratio of at least 1:5 will be used for all awards. USBC SMART account #9470 will receive all scholarship awards in the awardee's name. We are adding \$1000 to the prize fund from SMART account #9470 unassigned funds.
- 6. General Provisions:** Only participants and tournament personnel are allowed in the settee area. No food or drink is allowed in the settee area. No powdery product (e.g. Easy Slide, baby powder) may be applied to bowling shoes.
- 7. Protest/Appeals:** Any protest or appeal must be received by the GSA office within 72 hours of the infraction.
- 8. Rules:** USBC rules will govern any aspect of tournament play that is not specifically addressed in these rules.
